

# Four charities set to benefit

FOUR charities will share the proceeds from this year's Wings & Wheels.

They are Brooklands Museum, which organises the 'Wheels' element of the event; the Dunsfold-based Surrey and Sussex Air Ambulance; Cranleigh Village Hospital Trust, raising money for a new hospital; and Help For Heroes, which wants to build personnel recovery centres across the UK.

Wings & Wheels takes place on Sunday and Monday, August 29 and 30, and will be open to spectators from 9am to 6pm on both days.

Visiting aircraft will be flying in from 9am, with the first vehicle displays starting at 10.15am and the first half of the four-hour flying display beginning just before midday.

Ticket prices are the same as last year, starting from £16 for adults, £5 for under 15s and £36 for a family. Hospitality packages start at £120 per person.
